Our Teas

- Ceylon Kenilworth** Highly prized for its creamy character, subtle perfumed notes and rich body, this tea is grown at the high elevations of the esteemed Kenilworth estate in the western hills of Sri Lanka.
- Irish Breakfast** Delightfully right and malty teas from several distinguished Indian tea gardens, in and around the Assam region, are melded together to form this robust and traditional Irish blend. Distinctive nuttiness and hints of port wine in the finish provide for a clean and stout infusion
- Organic Assam Rani Estate** This rich & malty selection from a renowned Rani estate displays a slight nutty sweetness and a hint of wine notes with exquisite balanced strength. Enjoy an infusion of rich amber leaves that flourish in the shaded valleys of the Himilayan range.
- Organic Breakfast (Regular and Decafinated)** A robust blend of premium organic black tea leaves from India, punctuated with a hearty finish. Aromatic and brisk, it is great black or with milk and sugar or a touch of honey.
- Organic Darjeeling Estate** We have selected superior, single estate teas, from the Darjeeling region of India, which yield a subtle fruity and sweet, highly aromatic cup with a full-bodied, classic muscatel finish.
- Organic Lapsang Souchong** This rich Chinese tea is smoked over natural fir tree root. It produces an intensely smoky brew that is considered to be a unique gourmet treat.
- Yunnan Top Grade** The finest of the Yunnans, this tea boasts beautiful golden tipped leaves. Robust, yet balanced, this infusion is a mélange of light maltiness, delicate smoke and a touch of fruit in a red-orange liquor
- Bombay Chai** A mélange of spicy notes create an aromatic Indian delight of black tea leaves accented with subtle hints of pepper, orange, cinnamon, cardamom and clove. It's often served with warm milk for a soothing infusion.
- Organic Earl Grey** High-grown Ceylon and China black teas are combined with the smoky citrus notes of bergamot fruit. This tea produces an elegant, balanced, full-flavored classic cup.
- Mocha Pu-Erh** These handcrafted small golden leaf buds, one of the most difficult of the Pu-Erhs to produce, make this a rare and full-bodied tea from the Yunnan Province. In the cup, this deep amber tea is rich in flavor, smooth and savory with a hint of chocolate earthiness, accented by cacao nibs.
- Rose Pu-Erh Tuocha** Rich, peppery Pu-erh is infused with rose petals, pressed into the classic tuocha or "bowl" shape and enjoyed as a balanced contrast in flavors and aromas.
- Orchid Oolong** These fine oolong tea elaves are highlighted by a touch of coconut to offer a fragrant bouquet of fruit and floral notes in a rich, soothing infusion.
- Ti Kuan Yin/ Iron Goddess** This meditative, deep rich tea fills your palate with fruit-like flavor and a heady aroma. Good for multiple infusions.
- Chrysanthemum Silver Needle (Bai Hao Yin Zhen)** This highly sought-after white tea from China's Northern Fujian province is harvested for only a couple of days each spring, yielding exquisite buds enveloped in ivory down. Enriched with the buttery and subtle spicy notes of chrysanthemum flowers, its savory aroma and rich body make a smooth delicate cup.
- White Lotus** Gently spiked with accents of ginger and lemon myrtle, these white peony leaves are refreshing and cleansing. Nuances of spice and citrus engage the palate and offer a lingering finish.
- White Orchard** Refreshing fruits of melon and peach harmoniously blend with the delicate notes of pure China Bai Mu Dan white tea.

White Peony (Bai Mu Dan)	This elegant white Zhenghe varietal from China's Fujian province boasts a nutty, savory taste and sweet bamboo fragrance.
Organic Dragonwell (Longjing)	This most renowned Chinese green tea envelops the whole palate with a very refreshing, slightly sweet liquor. A classic wok-fired green tea from the Dragon Well in Zhejiang Province, it has a delicate flavor, captivating aroma, and a lovely yellow-green color.
Gunpowder	Slightly roasted in character, this is a classic Chinese cup.
Kyoto Rice (Genmaicha)	Japanese green tea leaves are blended with popped and roasted rice. It's a deep, brothy and nourishing infusion with a unique appeal of well-balanced herbal notes and nutty rice. The size and color of the rich dark green leaves and balanced proportion of rice comprise of the finest of genmaichas.
Organic Hojicha	Japanese roasted bancha- a mixture of leaves and stems pan-fired to impart a nutty flavor reminiscent of a roasted grain. Within the green tea category, this tea has lower levels of caffeine
Organic Karigane	Japanese Kukicha tea is a highly prized blend of stems, stalks and stray leaves derived from the production of reserve Gyokuru tea.
Organic Sencha	This beautiful Japanese green leaf resembles pine needles and produces a delicate fresh vegetal cup.
Green Tea Tropical	Healthy, soothing and refreshing, this fragrant blend of delicate green teas from Japan, China and Taiwan is accented by tropical fruits, including guava, pineapple and strawberry.
Marrakesh Mint	China Gunpowder is blended with refreshing Moroccan spearmint for a healthy, cool lift.
Organic Spring Jasmine	Layers of jasmine buds naturally scent Chinese green tea leaves for a gently piquant yet rounded aromatic cup.
Chamomile Citrus	A unique mélange of Egyptian chamomile, citrus slices, orange blossoms, lemongrass, rose hips, hibiscus, and mint. It's delicately fruity, soothing, and rich in Vitamic C.
Chocolate Mint Truffle	The fragrant aroma of chocolate mingles with fresh mint and soothing rooibos in this decadent infusion that is rich in antioxidants and appeals to the "kid" in all of us.
Coco Chai Rooibos	A handcrafted, caffeine-free chai tea made from South African rooibos blended with shredded coconut, red peppercorns and aromatic spices including ginger, cinnamon, and cardamom. This twist on a classic chai tea will surprise with its intoxicating aroma and spicy but sweet flavor.
Ginger Twist	A blend of Australian ginger, orange and lemon slices lemongrass, wintergreen mint, papaya, apple, ginseng and licorice. Ginger promotes focus and is a powerful antioxidant.
Organic Yerba Mate (Moderately Caffeinated)	Shade-grown to protect from direct sunlight, which can cause bitterness, the stems and leaves of the yerba mate tree brew up an infusion that is full-bodied and roasted. Mate possesses natural caffeine, vitamins, minerals, and antioxidants.
Wild Blossoms & Berries	Blackberry and black currant, infused with lemongrass, hibiscus, chamomile, mint, licorice root, and spices produce a hearty, memorable refreshment.
Aloe Serenity	Soothing and smooth with floral notes, this blend combines antioxidant-rich green tea leaves with rose petals that act as blood purifier, as calming aloe pairs with inulin which has been purported to boost bone strength and potentially even lower cholesterol.
Calming Moon	This full-bodied infusion offers a redolent blend of licorice, fennel, mints and citrus. Rich with vitamins C and B as well as zing, it counteracts stress, soothes the digestion and bathes the inner body in a calming elixir.
Embrace	Buttery-smooth organic verbena leaves combine with the soft touch of peppermint, finishing with a delicate lemon note. As calming verbena soothes the digestion and nerves, mint cleanses the body and clears the complexion.
